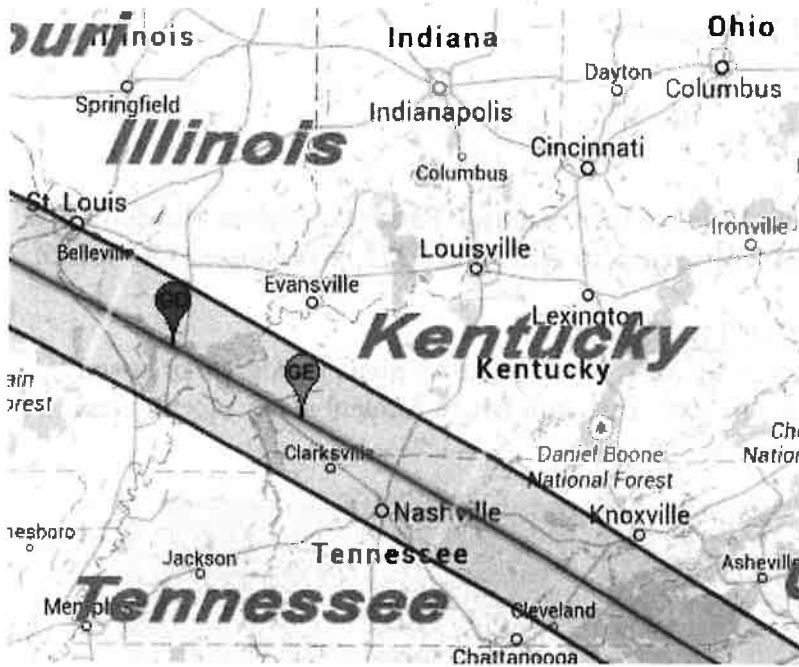

TOTAL ECLIPSE OF THE SUN ——— STAMPS on JUNE 20 ——— ECLIPSE on AUGUST 21:



The First Day of Issue Ceremony will be on 20 Jun at 1:30 pm MT at the Art Museum of the University of Wyoming, Laramie.

The total eclipse image was photographed by Fred Espenak at Jalu, Libya on March 29, 2006. The heat of a finger pressed on the eclipse image reveals the Moon image.

The stamp will be available at local post offices soon after the FDC. It will also be available from The Cave and the Post Office store on Ebay. All of the philatelic blogs I've read about this stamp (and the Post Office's expectations) indicate that this stamp will sell out quickly.

Columbus will see about an 80% eclipse, but as indicated by the map, an easy drive to the Nashville or Knoxville areas will provide the opportunity to view and photograph the eclipse.

I haven't seen any info yet, but hopefully, some clubs along the way will have special cancels for the event. – Hint, Hint to our WSC Member, Tom Ringenbach, down Knoxville way.
